GOAL: Coordinated, Focused, Optimized TSMO Program



• TSMO -

MAP-21

An integrated program focusing on multimodal system, operations, and maintenance throughout the entire transportation network.



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- Highway Authorizations typically cover 5-6 years.
- Last Highway Authorization (FAST Act) ended Sept 30, 2020.
- Annual Appropriations
- 1 year authorization extension and 72 day continuing resolution (appropriation)



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Infrastructure Proposal Elements

 Transportation/Infrastructure <> Clean Energy and Mitigating Climate Change

\$2 trillion Infrastructure Plan



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 Roads and Bridges: \$50 billion in the first year to repair existing roads, highways, and bridges; expedited permitting; boost long-term surface transportation funding to states that adopt smart climate design and pollution reduction options.
